- 5. Principal's Report Mr. Lempert
 - HV Dads finding a way to contribute to the school. One is a school mascot costume (a friendly viking). Purchased a new ozobot for Innovation Labs for TK. Also purchased 4 more iPads. Also donated Chromebook tower chargers for grades 4th-6th. Almost \$10,000 donation in total.
 - Discussed needing new balls. ASB and PAL are going to address it (and potentially partner with the HV Dads who originally donated). Want the kids to figure it out a bit. Grade level colors is helpful. But things still pop and disappear. Maybe a face to face check in and/or a shed would be helpful. Having big connect four together is good during body break.  - Attendance 3 years ago, 20% of pop was missing 18 days or more. Now much improved.

They alternate years (one year a secondary school is awarded, next year an elementary school). It used to be a grant to apply for it. Now they use the dashboard. In March, we will hear.
