- 4. Principal's Report Mr. Lempert
  - a. Boys would like dividers in between the urinals, Wyatt Meachum gave presentation. Issues with wheelchair access to small bathroom
  - b. JAT was great event thank you to the kids and parents
  - c. Harbor View Dads provided a Viking mascot costume
  - d. 14 new students enrolled who came from LA grea fires
    - i. HVE has been really open and welcoming
- 5. Teachers' Report Ms. Ericastilla
  - a. New student who joined her class is doing great, adjusting well, seamlessly integrating
- 6. NMUSD Board Trustee Area 4 Lisa Pearson
  - a. 34 new students from fires, HVE got 13 of them
  - b. So impressed with HVE community
  - c. Lisa is 1 of 7 trustee on the school board
  - d. She is here to hear what is most important to our families
  - e. District happenings:
    - i. One board member moved to city council
    - ii. Mid year test scores, HVE at the top 3 schools in the district
    - iii. Always happy to help
    - iv. Elementary schools:
      - 1. Little playgrounds will be redone (HVE summer of 2026)
        - a. Woodchips or soft ground?
      - 2. All elementary schools will have new AV systems this summer
      - 3. Safety:
        - a. 5 million spent on new camera systems
          - i. Same system used in olympics
    - v. State Mandate: Every child needs an ethnic studies class prior to graduation.
      - 1. Piloting at CDM
      - 2. Was not included in state budget
      - 3. There is a chance it will not be mandated after further review
      - 4. Carrie Torres in charge
      - 5. People are unhappy with ethnic studies program. Would like to know more about the program.

- a. NMUSD not taking state curriculum. Coming up with our own program.
- b. If not mandated, Lisa will probably vote no
- c. Lisa will go sit in on the class to review what is happening

#### Lisa Pearson forum:

- Ericastilla asked about declining enrollment?
  - HVE up 20 students from last year
  - TK Program helping with enrollment
  - Is TK funding in jeopardy?
    - TK is not state funded
    - TK really helps with early literacy
- Harbor view PFO pays for 3 additional full time teachers
- Parent choice: inter-transfer between schools
  - Will parent choice change class sizes?
  - Randy has no control over letting students into HVE
  - This is a district decision
- Higher fences?
  - Need to get all the other fences done and then we will evaluate other schools
- Summer school is coming back
  - We don't know location yet
- School lunches:
  - Superintendent does agree we need to do better
  - State has contracts with food companies
  - It is on the radar
