2. **Financial Report** - Meghan Michalovsky + Ane Piyavid

- April Financials
 - The latest big event was PNO
 - 145K inflows all related to PNO (overall about \$200K)
 - A lot of mini grants and teacher expenses are coming in this month
- 2026-27 Budget
 - Have set the budget for next year. We look at our budget the last couple years and then readjust based on the actuals.
 - Book Fair take budget down to \$2500
 - Cap Campaign going up to \$190K
 - \$90K budget for Jog-a-Thon
 - \$170K for PNO
 - \$70K for Read a Thon
 - Spirit gear going to \$8K (revenue and expenses)
 - School Play, Cap Campaign, Art Masters, Walk Throughs staying same
 - JAT expenses \$6500
 - Incentive parties down to \$4k
 - \$3K for academic clubs
 - Taking out mini-grants and merging with teacher expenses into one category
 - Interest rates higher (3 percent a month) on our money market account (get about \$1700 per month in interest). Will check with Farmers and Merchants and see if we can get a higher rate.
 - Added \$4K for field trips

 - They feel appreciated all the time, but this week was over the top!
